

## RESIDENT ORIENTATION

Welcome to the Division of Orthopaedic Surgery at St. Michaels' Hospital.

**Your First Day:** You are asked to meet with Dr. Emil Schemitsch on the morning of your rotation.

**Staff:** St. Michael's Hospital is a Quaternary referral hospital for orthopaedic problems. As a result, all of the staff surgeons have specific areas of sub-specialization. The staff surgeons and their areas of interest are as follows:

**Dr. Earl Bogoch** – Surgery of Arthritis and Rheumatic Disease.

**Dr. Tim Daniels** – Foot & Ankle.

**Dr. Michael McKee** – Trauma, Upper Extremity Reconstruction and Ilizarov.

**Dr. Emil Schemitsch** – Lower Extremity, TKA/THR and Trauma.

**Dr. Jim Waddell** – Lower Extremity, Joint Replacement and Foot.

### Orthopaedic Clinics

There are two types of orthopaedic clinics: the Fracture Clinic and the Martin Centre – new patient / research clinics.

**Fracture Clinic:** This is the clinic where patients with fractures are assessed and patients who have undergone an elective orthopaedic surgery are reviewed.
