


# Accessing Clinical Applications from home, using the Internet

To access clinical applications like Soarian and MagicWeb from outside SMH, you must have high speed internet access and administrative rights to the computer. You should have Acrobat Reader 7.0 on your machine and your web browser must be Explorer 6.1 or higher, but not version 7.0, and with Active X controls permitted.

## To access Soarian or MagicWeb:

1. Launch the Internet Explore browser and go to <http://remote.smh.ca/sca>

The **Clinical Remote Access** window opens.

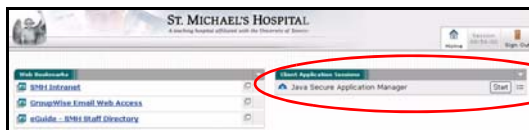


2. In the **Username** box, enter your Novell UserID.
3. In the **PIN + Code** box, type your unique pin number followed by the 6-digit code that appears on the **RSA SecurID** Token.



4. Click the **Login** button

The St. Michael's Remote Access menu page opens.



The **Client Application Session** menu is on the top right hand corner of the page.



5. On the **Client Applications Sessions** menu, click the **Start** button.

A small window pops up.



**NOTE:** Once you see the pop-up window, you are ready to access Soarian Clinicals.

## To access Soarian:

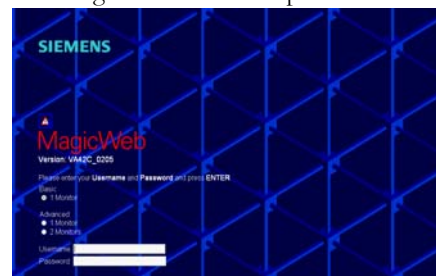
1. Open a new Internet Explorer window.
2. In the address box, type, <http://clinicals>  
The Soarian login window opens.
3. Log in to Soarian.

## To access Scheduling:

1. Open a new Internet Explorer window.
2. In the address box, type: <http://scheduling>  
The Scheduling window opens.
3. Log in to Scheduling

## To access MagicWeb directly:

1. Open a new Internet Explorer window.
2. In the address box, type:  
<http://diweb.smh.toronto.on.ca/magicweb>  
The Magic Web window opens.



3. Log in to MagicWeb.

**NOTE:** You can access MagicWeb either from inside the Soarian application, or directly in a new Internet Explorer window.
