Don't delay treatment

Assume that any disturbance of function is a bleed; treat with factor replacement therapy as quickly as possible



When in doubt, treat

There is no harm in giving a dose of Factor VIII or IX to a hemophilia patient who turns out to not be bleeding



Don't change your treatment approach

Hemophilia patients should not be denied necessary diagnostic or therapeutic procedures for medical conditions
