Career Counselling:

Establish your educational and career performance profile by identifying your likes, interests and abilities.

Vocational Assessments:

Identify occupations that are consistent with your aptitudes, interests and physical abilities.

Psychovocational Assessments:

Understand your learning and employment profile with a complete psychoeducational and vocational assessments designed to help you make realistic decisions about educational, training and career options.

Psychoeducational Assessments:

For children and adolescents struggling in school, youth going to post-secondary education, and adults pursuing education, a psychoeducational assessment provides a deeper understanding of learning profiles, strengths and challenges, and identifies Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Developmental Disabilities, reading (dyslexia), writing (dysgraphia) and mathematic (dyscalculia) challenges and other mental health issues (depression or anxiety) that can interfere with learning.

Anxiety Treatment:

One-on-one consultations to explore and evaluate anxiety treatment and provide Cognitive Behavioural Therapy with an experienced and qualified therapist.

Working Memory Treatment:

A five-week training program for people experiencing memory deficits, using Cogmed Working Memory Treatment Training. Start-up and wrap-up sessions are included.

Fees may apply to psychological services. As a non-profit, charitable organization, generous funding allows us to provide most services for free or with a subsidy for those who qualify.

Project GOLD:

Assisting adults with learning disabilities or ADHD to achieve and retain meaningful employment.

ASD Job-Readiness Program:

Job readiness skills, weekly one-on-one sessions, work experience placement, and on-site job coaching for job seekers aged 18 - 30, with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

AI Green Resource Centre:

Employment and volunteer training for individuals with developmental disabilities. Services include the following five specialty programs:

1. Person-Directed Planning Initiative:

Preparation and support for life transitions, volunteer positions, employment and/or education.

2. Developing Work Connections:

Provides life skills, employment skills and social group workshops for adults with developmental disabilities.

3. Youth: Community Choices for Success:

Support for youth with developmental and mental health disabilities that includes vocational planning, employment and life skills workshops, and volunteer placement.

4. Path 2 Work:

Helping people with developmental disabilities move into paid employment.

5. Adult-Literacy:

This one-on-one support program pairs volunteer tutors with individuals with disabilities to work towards their personal learning goals.
